The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) tentatively approves the revised Notice of Intention to Commence Large Mining Operations (NOI), received August 5, 2025. Prior to issuing final approval, the Division requires that you provide:

Bond amount concurrence from the applicable agencies Utah Trust Lands Administration (TLA) and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) for the reclamation surety was received on September 26, 2025.

The approval or acceptance of a complete NOI does not relieve an operator from his responsibility to comply with the applicable statutes, rules, regulations, and ordinances of all local, state and federal agencies with jurisdiction over any aspect of the operator's mining operations.

No mining related disturbance may be created until the surety is received. In addition, you must also have written acceptance from the Division as well as other applicable agencies.
