Caruso, and authorizing the Division to take any and all additional actions necessary to recover insufficient reclamation costs

[Docket No. 2026-017 Cause No. M0530059](#) – In the Matter of the Notice Of Agency Action wherein the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining requests the Board issue an order forfeiting the bond covering the Limestone Mesa/Desert Bronze Quarry, Permit No. M0530059, S40 T41S, R12W, SLMB, in Washington County, Utah, authorizing the Division to reclaim associated surface impacts from the operator, Southwest Stone, Inc., and authorizing the Division to take any and all additional actions necessary to recover insufficient costs of reclaiming the mine
