HEARING EXAMINER PROCEEDINGS

A public meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 15, 2026, at 9 a.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Soldier Hollow Room (Room 112) at the Department of Natural Resources, 1594 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah. The Board of Oil, Gas and Mining ("Board"), State of Utah, pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R641-113-100, has designated a Hearing Examiner to conduct the hearing. The Board will consider the Hearing Examiner's recommended findings of fact and conclusions of law at the Board Hearing on July 22, 2026. The Hearing Examiner will hear the following matters at or around 9 a.m.:

2. [Docket No. 2026-034 Cause No. 132-91](#) – In the Matter of the Request for Agency Action of WEM OPERATING, LLC for an order pooling all interests, including the compulsory pooling of all interests of non-consenting and unknown owners, within a 1,294.645-acre (or substantial equivalent) overlapping drilling unit established for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Lower Green River and Wasatch Formations, comprised of Sections 5 and 6, Township 4 South, Range 4 West, U.S.M., Duchesne County, Utah
